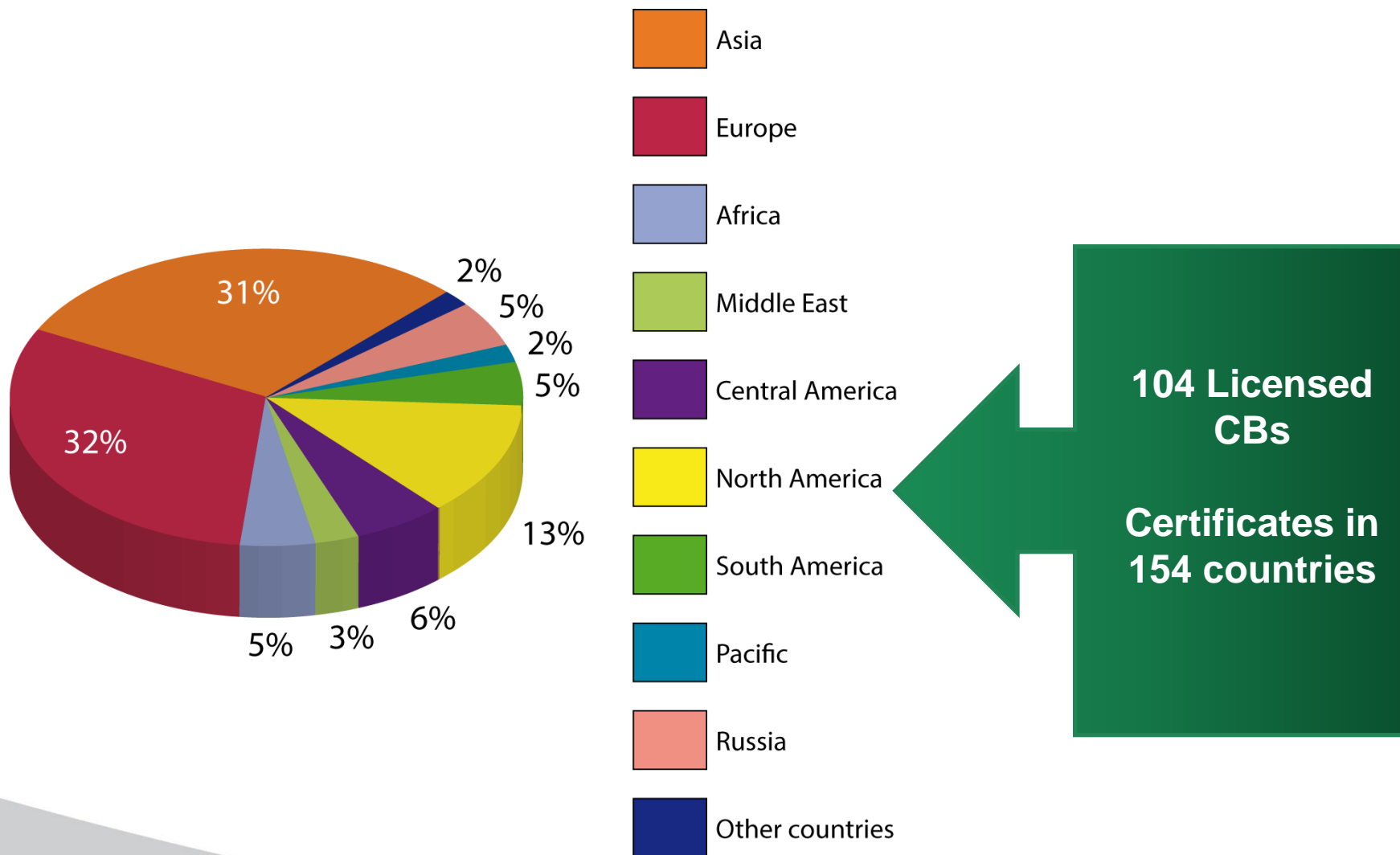

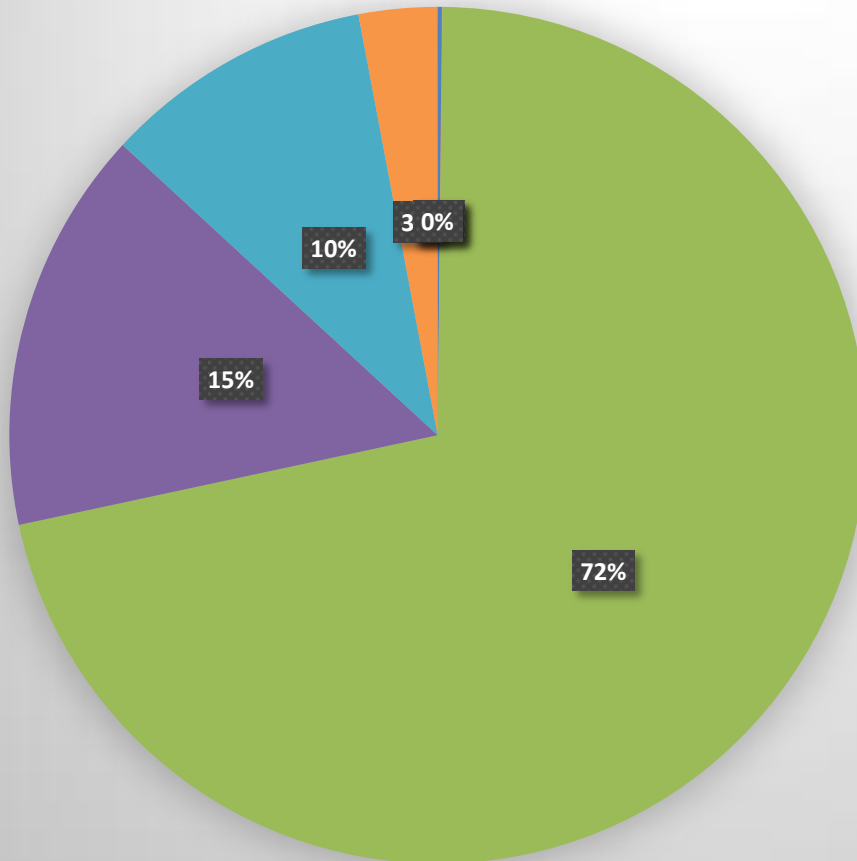


Geographic distribution

FSSC 22000 Scheme Version 4

- Version 1 (2010), V2 (2011) and V3 (2013)
- Need to revise the Scheme for V4 (2016):
 - Updating current FSSC 22000 Requirements
 - Expected publication of GFSI BR Version 7
 - Government expectations esp. NL, UK, FR and USA (FSMA)

FDA Food Safety Modernization Act

- Shared goals of food safety management through preventive controls and flexible management system approach
- Independent GAP analysis performed by TAG
- Good alignment indicated
- FSSC 22000 contributes to FSMA compliance

Global Markets Program

- Global Markets Program is being developed
- Market need to support SME suppliers
- Based on GFSI Global Markets Program and Codex HACCP
- Two compliance levels:
 - Foundation
 - Intermediate

GMP Planning

- Final draft requirements finished
- Audit process requirements under development
- Pilot audits in November 2016
- Scheme published in Q1 2017
- CBs can be licensed from Q1 2017 onwards
- Licensed CBs and certified organizations on dedicated website

- Scope extensions in place
- GFSI Recognition

- Activate working relationship with ABs
- Transition terms:
